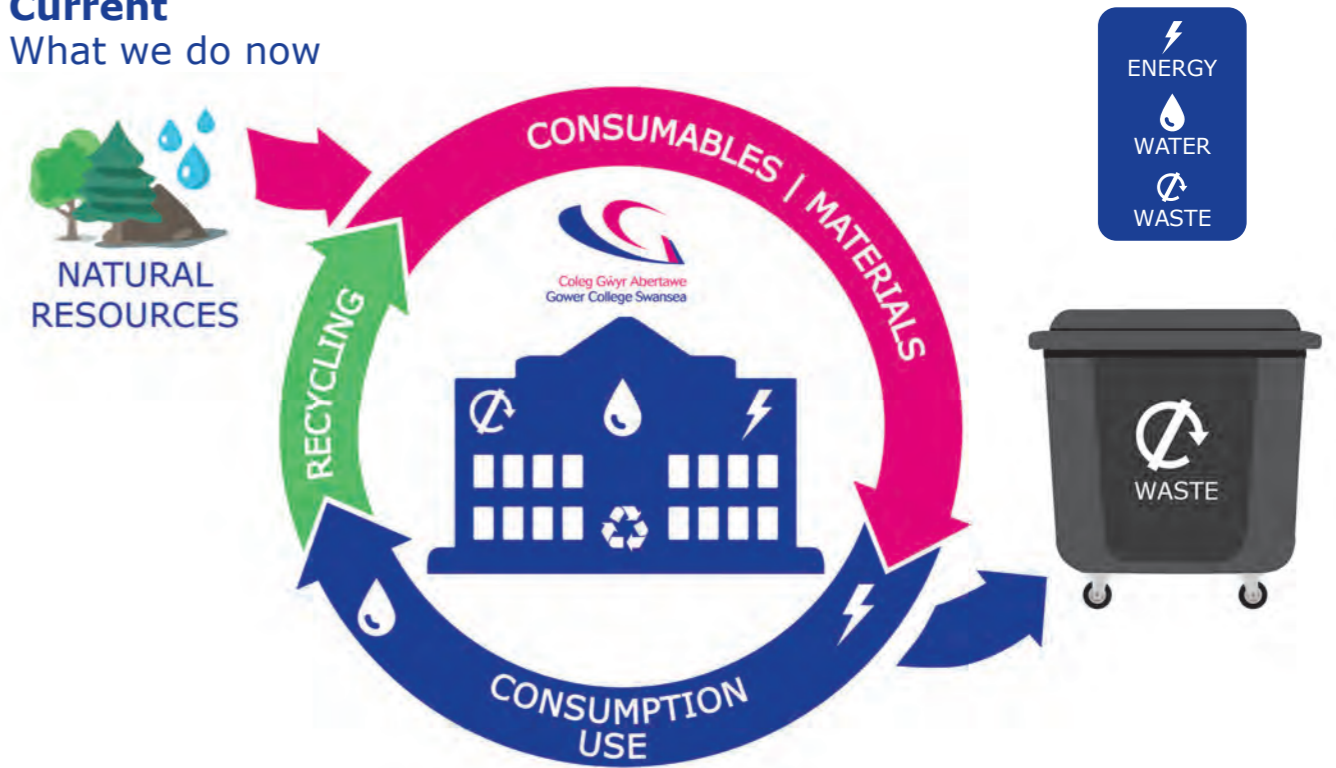


The Circular economy we strive toward

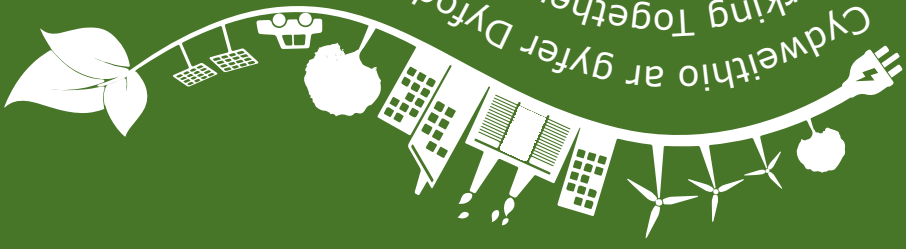
